At the end of the first academic period, including our Summer session, a total of \$3,231,162.09 has been disbursed to students.

At this time our remaining balance is \$3,420,505.91. These funds will be distributed to students that enroll in our Second Quarter, starting January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The amount to be received by each student will depend on how many enroll; the exact number of students will be known by the end of this week (January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022), when our extended enrollment period ends.
